Dr Sameer Kaul | MBBS FRACP Respiratory & Sleep Physician

Topic: Historical background Epidemiology and Screening

Dr Sameer Kaul is a consultant Respiratory Physician on the Peninsula whose interests include all facets of Respiratory and Sleep medicine with a concentration in chronic lung disease, diagnostic assessments in lung cancer and sleep-related respiratory disorders including non-invasive ventilation.



Mr Adrian Pick | MBBS, FRACS (Cardiothoracic Surgeon)

Topic: Modern surgical techniques in the diagnosis and management of Lung Cancer

Mr. Pick is highly specialised in both cardiac and thoracic surgery. On the thoracic side of the practice, Mr. Pick specialises in keyhole procedures for lung cancer. He will make a determination of how much lung needs to be removed, in order to cure a patient of their lung cancer. Variably it could be a wedge, a lobe or even an entire lung. Mr Pick provides a lung cancer surveillance program for five years after resection of lung cancer, as well as tissue retrieval for characterisation, and palliative procedures for pleural effusions (pleurodesis).



Dr David Blakey | MBBS, FRANZCR (Radiation Oncologist)

Topic: Current practices in Radiation Oncology in the management of Lung Cancer

Dr David Blakey is actively involved with the introduction of a number of technological advances in radiation therapy at Frankston, to support the treatment of a number of tumour streams including intensity modulated and image guided radiotherapy for prostate and other cancers, deep inspiration breath hold radiation therapy for breast cancer, and stereotactic brain and body radiotherapy.



A/Prof Muhammad Alamgeer | MBBS, MD MRCP FRACP (Medical Oncologist)

Topic: Best Practice and Timely Management Of Lung Cancer

A/Prof Muhammad Alamgeer is a medical oncologist specializing in the treatment of thoracic malignancies and Head & Neck cancers. He completed Victorian Medical Oncology Training programme and completed fellowship at Peter McCullum Cancer Centre. He was subsequently awarded a Doctor of Medical Science degree by Monash University. A/Prof Alamgeer is a lead investigator on several clinical and translation studies. He is an active member of Australasian Lung Cancer Trial Group, International Association of Study in Lung Cancer, Australian and New Zealand Head and Neck Cancer Society. His research has been published in many scientific journal and presented at multiple international conferences.
